

## Dual Enrollment Guidelines

1. 9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grade students who have passed the PLAN, ACT, PSAT, SAT or Accuplacer test and have a (preferred) 3.0 or above GPA. Students must pass the Accuplacer placement test qualifying scores from MCC to take their courses.
2. A student must be in at least one class at Grant High School during the school day. The student cannot enroll in more than 10 dual enrollment courses.
3. The total number of classes taken each semester must be at least 5 out of 6.
4. Students are expected to spend an hour of studying for each hour they are in class.
5. If Grant High School is in session and the college class(es) is not in session, students should be using their time for studying in the high school library. If the college is in session, and Grant High School is not, students are still expected to be in the class unless prior approval from the instructor has taken place (spring break). Students aren't required to attend when GHS is canceled (such as snow day) but it is recommended to check online for missing work.
6. For a college class to be eligible it must not be offered at Grant High School and cannot be one of the following types of classes: Hobby; Craft, Recreation, Physical Education, Theology, Divinity, or Religious Education.
7. Grant Public Schools will NOT pay for transportation to the college, parking costs, or student activity fees (unless riding the CTC bus to NC RESA).
8. Nor will Grant Public Schools be financially responsible for the results of any illegal driving behavior between schools.
9. All final grades must be submitted to Grant Public Schools for verification purposes. If taking the course for High School or NCAA credit, a **letter grade** will be given on the HS transcript. If taking the course for college credit, **CR or NC** will be given.
- 10. If a college class is dropped beyond the drop deadline or failed by the student, the student is responsible for paying for the course. If the student fails a college course, Grant Public Schools will not pay for the student to take additional dual enrolled classes.**
